OTHER INFORMATION AND DETAILS	<p>All talks are required to choose the category for which their presentation is best aligned with:</p> <p><b>Research:</b> presenting original data and analysis from surveys, experiments, or other methods</p> <p><b>Teaching:</b> matters of pedagogical practices, curricula, student engagement in the classroom, course design, or other pedagogical practices and insights.</p> <p><b>Theory and ideas:</b> analysis of available data, persuasive arguments, theoretical frameworks, or original ideas.</p> <p>Single presenters will be grouped into 80 minute sessions with three single presenters on related topics.</p> <p>Presenters will have a computer, microphone, and screen to display powerpoint and other visual materials.</p>	<p>All talks are required to choose the category for which their presentation is best aligned with:</p> <p><b>Research:</b> presenting original data and analysis from surveys, experiments, or other methods</p> <p><b>Teaching:</b> matters of pedagogical practices, curricula, student engagement in the classroom, course design, or other pedagogical practices and insights.</p> <p><b>Theory and ideas:</b> analysis of available data, persuasive arguments, theoretical frameworks, or original ideas.</p> <p>Symposia submissions should explain the overarching theme of the symposium and how each presentation contributes to the theme.</p> <p>Presenters will have a computer, microphone, and screen to display powerpoint and other visual materials.</p>	<p>Panel discussions will feature 3-4 presenters sitting in chairs having a discussion on a topic related to the conference theme or HxA's mission.</p> <p>We strongly recommend one of the four presenters serves as the moderator of the session to pose questions to panelists, keep the conversation on topic, and facilitate Q&amp;A from the audience.</p> <p>Panel presenters will each be provided with a chair and microphone. No computers or presentations will be shown for panel discussions.</p>	<p>Workshops should be designed to provide attendees with practical advice, tools, and experiences to facilitate professional development.</p> <p>Workshops should provide participants with the opportunity to engage with experts, partake in dynamic discussions, and/or collaborate in hands-on activities that will equip them with skills that can be implemented in their academic and professional roles.</p> <p>Workshop rooms will be equipped with a computer, microphone, and screen to display powerpoint and other visual materials. Rooms will also have tables for attendees to work at collaboratively with other attendees.</p>	<p>Heterodox Conversations™ are signature HxA events that pair two scholarly experts with divergent viewpoints on a topic. These events showcase the power of academic dialogue and constructive disagreement in the shared pursuit of knowledge. Heterodox Conversations™ should be framed as a question that invites nuanced perspectives without a clear yes or no answer and should not be framed as a debate.</p> <p>You can see an <a href="#">example of these events here</a>.</p> <p>Heterodox Conversations™ must follow the below format:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Speaker Presentations</b> Each speaker has 15 minutes to present their scholarship on the topic.</li> <li><b>2. Speaker Conversation</b> (20 minute total): Speakers engage in dialogue with each other about their work.</li> <li><b>3. Audience Q&amp;A</b> (30 minutes): The audience is invited to pose questions and comments for the speakers.</li> </ol> <p>We recommend each session have a moderator/host to keep time, introduce speakers, and help keep the session on track through each phase.</p> <p>Rooms will be equipped with a computer, microphones, and screen to display powerpoint and other visual materials. Rooms will also have two chairs available for presenters to use while engaging in their conversation.</p>
