~ Victorian Jewels and Other Gems tour is 10 blocks long with two optional detours that add about 5 blocks and starts at the Historic Ivinson Mansion (1.5 miles from Gateway Conference Center)

~ Queen Annes and Common Folks tour is 14 blocks long and starts 1.3 miles from Gateway Conference Center

~ Grand Finale tour is 10 blocks long with an optional detour that adds one block and starts 0.7 miles from Gateway Conference Center
